



Forest School Clothing Checklist

It is important that children feel relaxed and confident to play freely—and to get muddy—during their weekly Forest School sessions. Please reassure them that they are wearing suitable clothing chosen specifically for these activities, so it doesn't matter if their clothes become dirty or marked.

We aim to spend time outdoors in all weather conditions, unless there are storms or high winds. Therefore, it is essential that your child brings a waterproof jacket (ideally with a hood) and waterproof footwear. There is no need to purchase expensive or branded items—an old coat and a pair of wellington boots will be perfectly suitable.

Autumn and Spring Term Forest School Clothing:

A waterproof coat

T-shirt (base layer), jumper and warm long trousers/leggings/tracksuit bottoms

Wellingtons, waterproof boots or old trainers

Hat and gloves on colder days

Summer Term Forest School Clothing:

A thin waterproof coat

Full sized T-shirt (not cropped or vests), hoodie and leggings/tracksuit bottoms

Sunhat

Sunscreen (already applied)

Clothes should be clearly **named** and brought into school on your child's designated Forest School day in a named bag.
